

Advanced EANx/Deco Procedures Equipment List

All of the following items are required for each student. If you have questions about any of the equipment needed or if equipment you are considering meets the criteria for the course, contact the instructor.

Cylinders

- Large Volume cylinder. 95 cubic feet per cylinder minimum (DIN valve preferred)
- Deco/pony cylinder. 19 cubic feet minimum and O2 clean. (DIN valve preferred) and appropriate mounting hardware.

Buoyancy Compensator

- Back inflation BC. 40 lb lift minimum and stainless steel D-rings on shoulders and waist.

Regulators

- 1-High performance 1st stage with 36' (minimum) hose for the second stage and 1 low-pressure inflator hose for bc.
- Alternative air Source attached to primary regulator (Safe Second or Air2)
- 1-1st and 2nd stage that is O2 clean with an octopus length hose, with either a pony SPG or a standard SPG with short hose.
- Pony/Deco regulator: should be similar quality to Primary, with SPG. Pony (backmounted) cylinders must have an approved In-line shutoff valve

Instruments

- 2 depth gauges and timing devices. Personal dive computers are preferred.
- 1 compass. Slate mounted or wrist mounted.

Exposure Protection

- Dry suit with hood and gloves are preferred.
- Argon system recommended.

Basic Equipment

- Mask (low volume preferred)
- Fins (hi-performance required)
- 2 cutting devices (small knives, sheers, z-knife...)
- Slate
- 1 Primary light & 1 Backup light
- 1 Surface marker bag (50 lb lift minimum and no-spill style preferred)
- 1 Reel with appropriate line length
- Surface signaling device
- Note: PLEASE no retractors, Snappy-Coil retrainers!

Rebreather divers

- RB must be suitable for Decompression dives (no Explorers for Deco P. class please)
